

# ISLPR Online English Course: Develop your English Skills in 14-Weeks


#### Class size:

We are limiting the number of participants in the course to ensure the tutors can provide course attendees with as much useful feedback as possible.

#### AIM OF THE COURSE

The aim of the course is to help participants develop their language proficiency. It provides advice and recommends activities in all four macroskills (speaking, listening, reading and writing). The focus is on developing your practical language skills with specific advice on aspects of each skill including, for example, pronunciation in speaking, grammar in speaking and writing, skimming and scanning in reading and a variety of experience in listening. All workbooks end with specific advice on using what has been taught in real-life activities. This is a practical course intended to help you develop your everyday ability in English.

#### **COURSE DELIVERY**

Workbooks will be emailed to you every Saturday morning in PDF format. Workshops will be conducted via Zoom every Friday.

The time of the Friday workshop is pending. The workshop will either commence at 10 AM (AEST) or 3 PM (AEST). This will be confirmed before enrolment opens on Wednesday, 29 April 2020.

## What can you expect?

Every Saturday at 5 AM (AEST), you will be sent a new workbook via email. Each workbook will have a different focus (see the course outline below) and will provide theory and practicals to complete. The workbook must be completed and emailed back to <a href="mailto:info@islpr.org">info@islpr.org</a> by 9 AM every Thursday. Any questions you have should be posted to the private Facebook group (in the applicable thread) by 10 AM every Thursday.

Every Friday you will be invited to attend a Zoom workshop. This group workshop will run for one to two hours and be conducted by one of our accredited tutors. During the workshop, your tutor will go through the workbook for the week and provide answers. Any questions you post in the group will be answered during this workshop. During the workshop, 30 minutes or so will be set aside to discuss the practical activities you were required to complete during the week. You will be required to orally discuss the "real-life use" activity that you completed for the week.

# **PREREQUISITES**

There are no specific prerequisites for this course. However, basic English is required.

#### Who is this course suitable for?

Anyone wanting to improve their English skills whether they are in Australia or other countries. For example:

- People who want to further develop their English,
- Teachers from overseas wishing to register to teach in Australia or New Zealand who need help in improving their English skills,
- International students wanting to enter Australian or New Zealand universities, Colleges or Secondary Schools who need help in improving their English skills,
- Other people wanting to get vocational registration in Australia or New Zealand who need help in improving their English skills.

#### What do you get?

- 14 workbooks, each designed to focus on a particular skill.
- Up to 28 hours of contact time with a tutor over the 14-week programme.
- Access to a private Facebook group to ask questions and engage with other participants (a great way to practise your English with like-minded people!)
- A certificate of course completion.
- If you pay up-front you will be given a free 15-minute consultation with the tutor to ask any questions about your proficiency.

You should download **Zoom** and create a free account before this course commences. All workshops will be conducted via Zoom.

## ABOUT THE COURSE CREATORS

These workbooks have been developed by Dr David Ingram (creator of the ISLPR test and many others) and Jenny Tamiya (accredited ISLPR tester and tutor).

The creators of this course have, together, over 60 years' experience in English language teaching. During these years they have come to learn what the most frequent issues are when a person is learning English as a second language. This 14-week course was designed to help ESL learners improve all aspects of their English though there is a particularly strong focus on writing (the most problematic skill).

# Terms and Conditions for the Online Course

- 1. The course is intended to help you develop your English.
- 2. This is not a test preparation course but a language development course. If you would like to familiarise yourself with the ISLPR test format, please read our blog.
- 3. The ISLPR test and an ISLPR rating is not included in the fees for this course.
- 4. The certificate you are provided at the end of this course is a *Certificate of Course Completion*. It does not replace the need for you to take an ISLPR test for official purposes, such as teacher registration or university entrance.
- 5. Though no course can honestly guarantee an outcome, many years of research have demonstrated that if learners seriously follow the advice given throughout this course their language is most likely to develop.
- 6. Your success on this course depends on the effort you put into following up the advice provided. It is your responsibility to submit workbooks and questions on time. Workbooks must be emailed to <a href="mailto:info@islpr.org">info@islpr.org</a> no later than 9 AM, every Thursday. Questions must be posted to the Facebook group no later than 10 AM, every Thursday. If your workbook or question is received after these times your tutor may not review your work.
- 7. The course is intended for learners who have already achieved at least basic English proficiency. It focuses on areas of particular need that we have identified from testing and tutoring many candidates over the past 40 years.
- 8. If you elect to pay full fees upfront you are eligible for a free 15-minute consultation about the course and your readiness for a test based on the work you have done. This will be a one-to-one consultation with a course tutor.
- 9. Workbooks will be sent to the email address listed on your application form. Workbooks are sent at 5 AM (AEST) every Saturday.
- 10. Accredited ISLPR tutors are responsible for the conduct of the workshops. Attendees are not permitted to interrupt. If you have a question you should so indicate in the chat. During the dedicated question time, the tutor will allow candidates to ask their questions (orally). Questions will be answered in chronological order depending on the time available.
- 11. During workshops, the tutor will go over the most common errors they came across in the workbooks. Tutors will also provide answers to any questions in the workbooks so you can compare answers.
- 12. If you miss a workshop the recording will be made available to the Facebook group. Access to the Facebook group expires 7 days after the course ends (14 August 2020).
- 13. Workshops differ from ISLPR tutorials as workshops are not one-to-one classes.

# **Enrolment Agreement Terms**

- 1. By accepting these terms, the participant agrees to pay the Course fees (including GST) for the Course using the payment method selected on the enrolment form.
- 2. The participant accepts that he/she is required to pay the full amount of the Course fees even if he/she does not complete the Course.
- 3. If you pay by the month and miss a payment, you will not receive the next workbook until payment has cleared. Failure to pay within 5 business days will mean you are immediately removed from the course.

## **FAQS**

## I only need help with my writing. Can I only sign up for part of the course (e.g. writing only)?

In short, we do not recommend this. You are welcome to sign up for the course and only complete the workbooks that interest you. Discounts cannot be offered to candidates who only want to take part of the course. The course was developed with the aim of improving a person's speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills. If a course were developed to improve one skill only, it is likely the course would be structured quite differently to the one on offer.

If you would like help with just one skill, we highly recommend you take advantage of our <u>5 Tutorial</u> <u>Package</u> that is on offer until 30 June 2020. The tutorial package will provide you with personalised help and can focus on the one skill you need help with.

#### Are there language requirements?

Yes. A person intending on taking this course should have basic English skills.

#### What should I do if I miss a workshop?

Recordings of the workshop will be available to watch after each workshop. These videos will be uploaded to the Facebook group.

## How do I register?

Enrolments open on Wednesday, 29 April 2020. You will need to register via our website.

#### When should I register?

As we are limiting the number of participants, you should register as soon as possible.
